### **BOARD ELECTION**

As previously announced in January, Hiway has three open positions for the 2019 Board of Directors Election. Nominations to the slate of candidates are made by the Nominating Committee or by a petition to the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee has selected Doug Differt, Lori Hodapp and Pam Tschida, all incumbents, for the slate of candidates. No petitions were received for this year's election.

With three candidates for three available positions, Hiway will not conduct an election by ballot for 2019. Per Hiway's Bylaws, if the number of nominees equals the number of open positions, the election will not be conducted by ballot and there will be no nominations from the floor.

The Osseo Maple Grove Squirt C White team was selected at random from all eligible teams to receive the party, a behindthe-scenes tour of the Xcel Energy Center, a meet-and-greet with Dubnyk and other Wild players and gifts from the Wild and Hiway.

Every player from a team that raised at least \$500 received a custom Minnesota Wild - Hockey Kids4Kids cap and all participating teams are invited to private skating parties at the Xcel Energy Center compliments of Hiway.
